"Cheryl, you're Catholic – you just don't know it!" claimed her friend, Judy.

Surprisingly, during an Evangelical retreat, Cheryl came upon an religious icon of a chalice on a table, surrounded by the Persons of the Holy Trinity. The icon transfixed Cheryl. She felt that the icon spoke to her, revealing an invitation to the Holy Eucharist. This life-transforming experience put her on a fast track. She told her husband that she wanted to explore Catholicism.

"My husband is very supportive of my faith walk." Cheryl explains that although her husband has no plans to become Catholic – at this time – he does enjoy listening to St. Gabriel Radio with her.

Cheryl began to read about the Holy Eucharist and the Early Church Fathers.

A skeptical, practical kind of person, Cheryl's mother said that she had heard a voice, not once but twice, saying to her, "You need to become Catholic."

Cheryl responded to her mother's announcement, "Mom, you don't just join the Catholic Church! You need to go through RCIA first." In fact, her mother did go on to complete RCIA and entered the Church at Easter Vigil last year in St. Catherine parish, at the age of 84.

Cheryl is especially grateful for the support from Judy Gerardi, who recently passed away following heart surgery. Judy was sponsoring Cheryl through RCIA at Our Lady of Perpetual Help in Grove City, Ohio. Cheryl mourns the loss of her sponsor and friend and continues her RCIA formation with a new sponsor, Mary Gamble. Cheryl asks her AM 820 radio family

to pray for the soul of her dear friend. Cheryl plans to enter the Church as soon as a previous marriage is annulled.

In the meantime, she is part of a wide circle of family and friends who are being fed by the teachings of the Catholic faith on AM 820. Cheryl says, "I knew in my heart that these teachings on AM 820 were the right track as they added layer on layer of richness to my spiritual life."
